

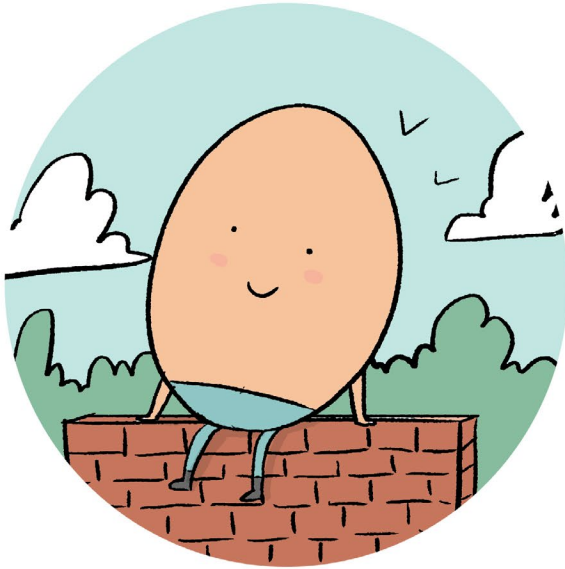

Humpty Dumpty



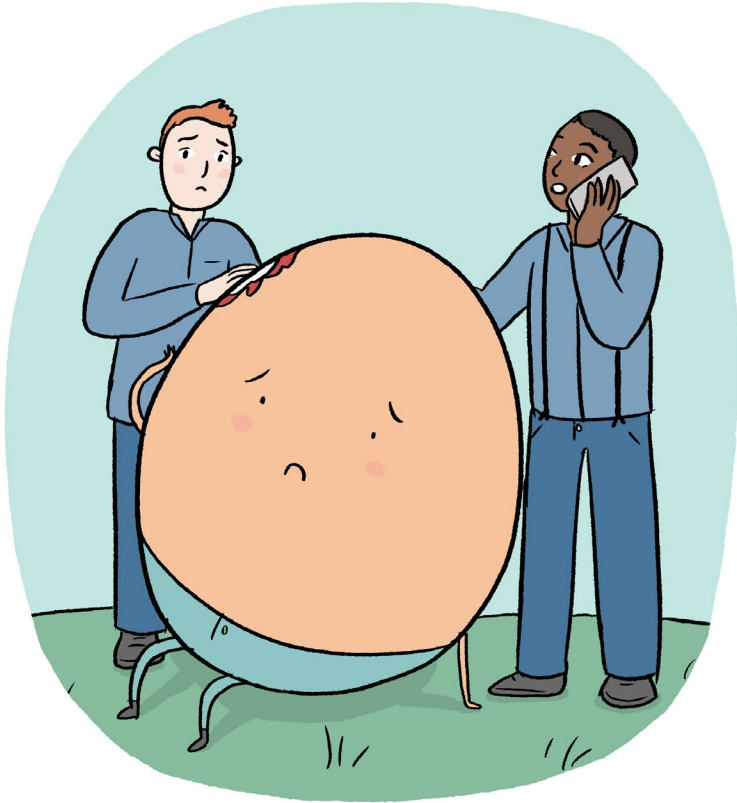
Humpty-Dumpty sat

the King's men...



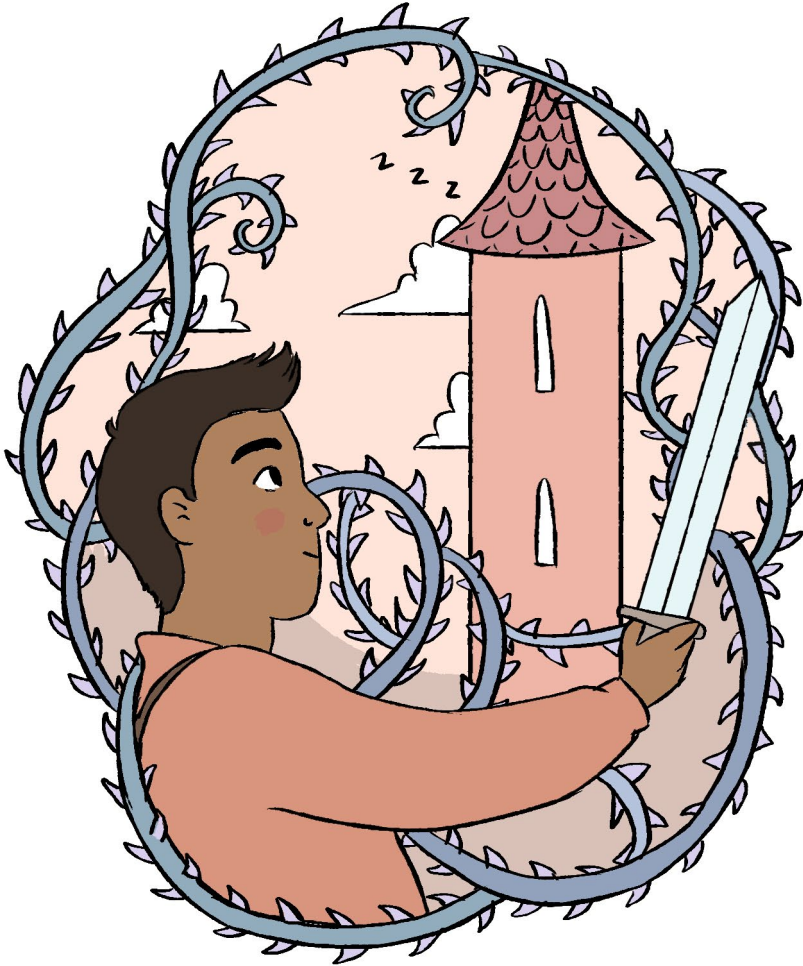
Couldn't put Humpty together again.



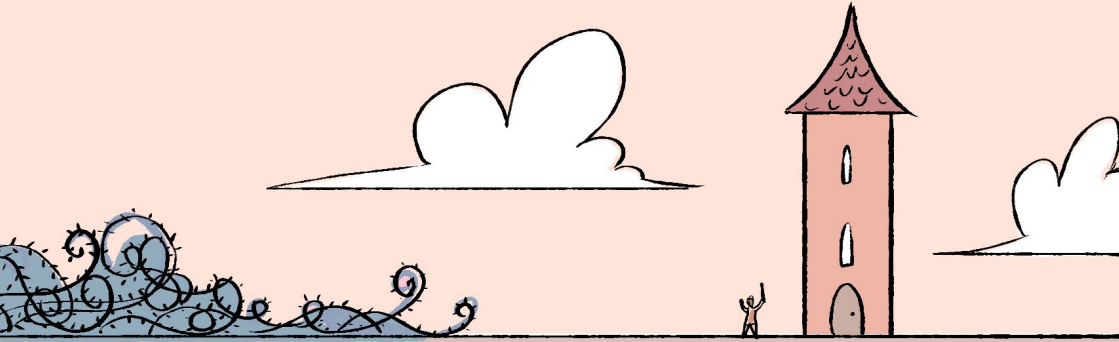
So, a super smart thinking man phoned 999, and they sent an ambulance in super quick time.

The handsome Prince is on his way to bravely rescue Sleeping Beauty from the tower.



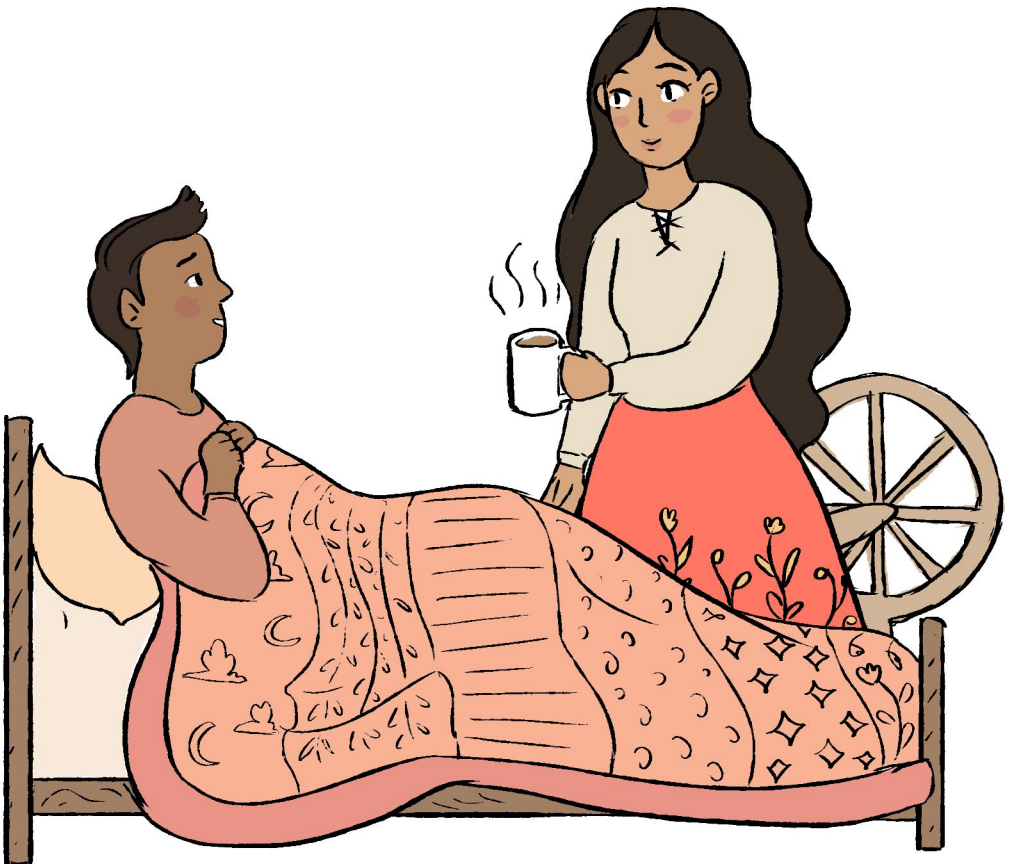
The Prince finds Sleeping Beauty –
she is saved!



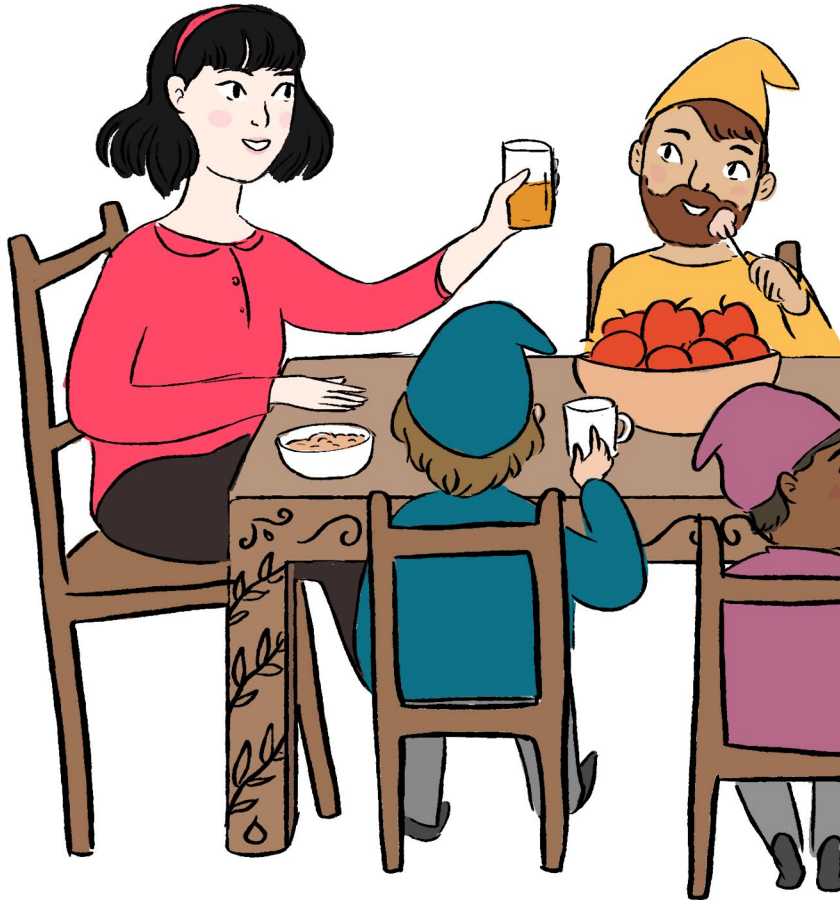

Whilst they are out Snow White eats an apple, but she forgets she's allergic to them. They make her feel very ill.

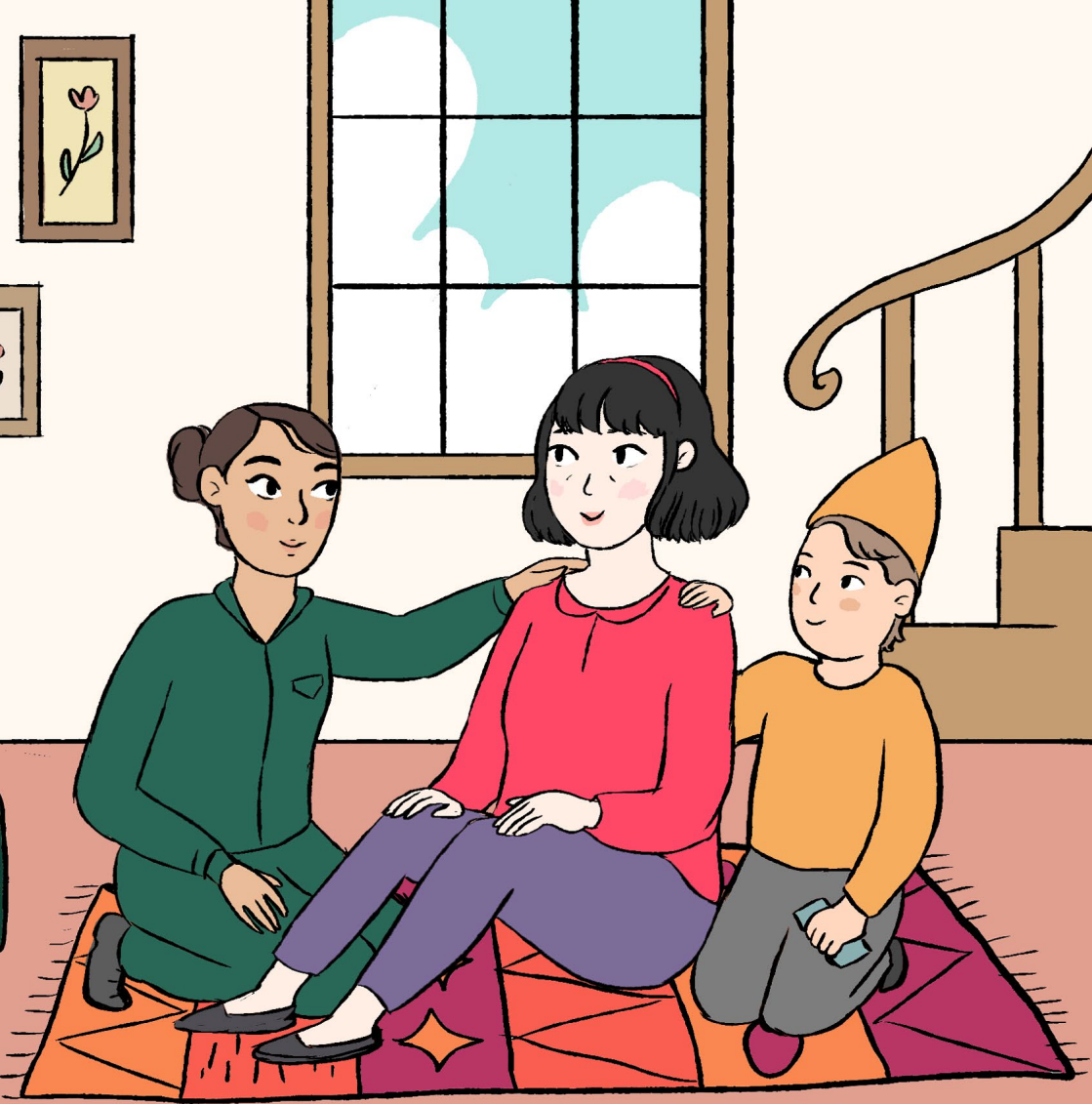


Luckily for Snow White, Sniffley has come home to rest. He has some medicine to make him feel better.



Sniffley sees that Snow White is sick and calls an ambulance. Don't forget, you should only dial **999** when you think someone is very ill.



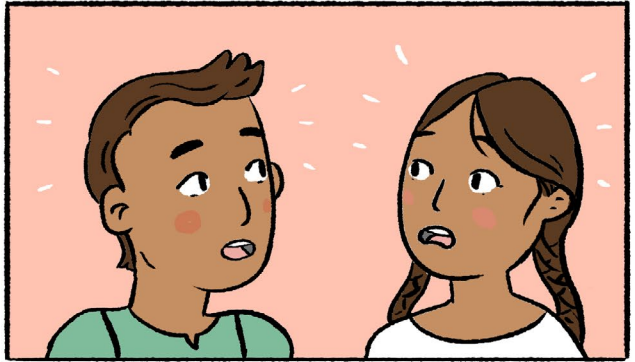


Thanks to Sniffley's quick thinking,

They hear something.

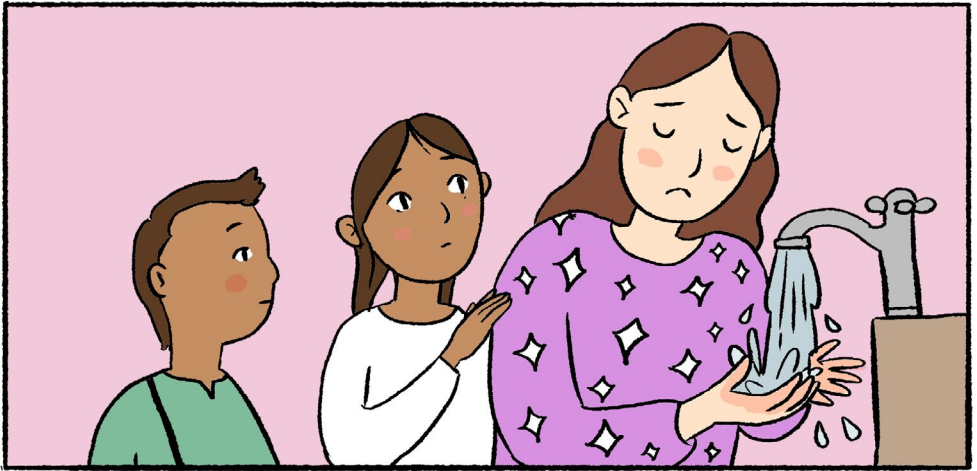


It sounds like someone's had an accident and
